CONIGLIO 2005 CABERNET SAUVIGNON (DIAMOND MOUNTAIN)

The 2005 Diamond Mountain Cabernet Sauvignon exhibits a deep purple color. The nose is packed with blueberries and a toasty mocha balanced with hints of stone fruit. Opulent fruit flavors balance this sophisticated wine with toasty oak and rich supple tannins. The wine is endowed with a symphony of crisp cassis and redcurrant together with a silky elegant finish. This elegant wine can be enjoyed now and will benefit from the accompaniment of full flavored foods or a nice juicy steak. This wine will also develop with cellar aging as the fruit, acid and tannins perform their intricate dance through time.

The Vineyard

The vineyard is located on the edge of a volcanic crater on Diamond Mountain, along the western ridge of the Napa Valley. This vineyard combines shallow, well-drained volcanic soils and a long cool growing season.
